



SEVEN NON-NEGOTIABLES

The cosmic conflict between God and Satan (good and evil), described in the Biblical canon, provides an unequalled framework for understanding the cosmos.

Love, properly understood within the context of this cosmic conflict, provides the theological basis for a more accurate interpretation of the **eschaton** (the end times). Without the cosmic conflict framework, doctrinal and prophetic conclusions are likely to be incomplete, inaccurate, and incoherent.

SEVEN NON-NEGOTIABLES

1. The cosmic conflict of love paradigm is essential to establishing an accurate view of God.
2. An accurate view of God is essential to understanding God's covenantal relationship not only to Israel, but to all humanity.
3. An accurate understanding of God's relationship to humanity is essential to understanding God's sovereignty as demonstrated in five distinct types of Bible prophecy:
 - a. Messianic
 - b. Judaic
 - c. Day of the Lord
 - d. Local
 - e. Apocalyptic
4. An accurate understanding of God's sovereignty is essential to understanding The Gospel of the Kingdom of Jesus Christ.
5. An accurate understanding of the Gospel of the Kingdom is essential to understanding five pillar doctrines of the Bible:

a. Atonement - Salvation	Love and Life
b. Sanctuary - Temple	God's Presence
c. Sabbath - Rest	Creation and Worship
d. Second Coming	Revelation of Jesus Christ
e. Death - Hell	Merciful Justice
6. An accurate understanding of the five pillar doctrines is essential to "unlocking" the rules of interpretation applied to Bible prophecy.
7. The prophetic rules of interpretation are essential to eschatological conclusions being coherent with the entirety of the biblical canon.
